Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <u>Those who meet both requirements below</u> ① <u>Students living outside of Seoul (Criterion: Registered address of the applicant)</u> ② <u>Undergraduate students: Those enrolled for 26-Fall full-time OR credit registered students who are taking 10 or more than 10 credits</u> ※ Re-admitted students should apply ONLY AFTER when tuition payment is completed and when registration is finalized ※ <u>The academic status of residents will be checked in early October after it has been finalized. Those who do NOT meet the requirements above will be evicted immediately</u> ※ <u>If a student is selected for 26-Fall dormitory but cancels their residency OR has their assignment canceled due to non-payment of fees, they will not be allowed to reapply for dormitory for the same semester</u> (however, it is possible to apply for winter vacation-period residence only)

5. Required Documents for Check-In

- ※ All documents should be in hard copy (showing a picture of the document or sending an electronic copy is not possible)
- ※ In order to protect personal information, please erase the last 6 digits of your RC number when submitting documents
- ※ In case any document is missing or insufficient, students will be denied to move in to the dormitory

1. Tuberculosis Test (Chest X-Ray) Result (only in Korean OR English) Issued From 2026. 6. 1.(Mon)

- A. The tuberculosis test (chest X-ray) certificate must show negative results
- B. The document should be in printed form stating your name, result and date of the examination. The office accepts original documents and copied forms as well

2. Proof of Residence (Submit One of the Following) Issued From 2026. 6. 1.(Mon)

- A. Domestic residents: A certificate of resident registration under your name
- B. Overseas Koreans: A proof of your foreign residence under your name
- C. Students whose parents live abroad while the student is living in Korea: A proof of parents' foreign residence, a certificate of family relations
- D. International students: copy of your passport or registration card

6. Important Information

▣ Room Assignment and Residence

1. Roommate/room type may not match your choice 100% and your roommate can be either an international or Korean student
2. Any request for room/building change will not be accepted
3. As the dormitory is a community space, there may be various difficulties and inconveniences (noise, communication

problems among room/unit mates etc.)

4. E-House is a suite-style dormitory with single/double/triple/quad rooms in 2-10 person suites. The number of people assigned means the number of people allocated per room, not per unit
5. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students so male residents may reside in the same building

■ Check-in and Check-out

1. You cannot visit the dorm room before the check-in date (early check-in is not allowed)

2. If you cancel your residency or leave the dormitory during the semester, all of your subsequent dormitory applications will be automatically canceled. If you plan to apply for residency again, you can apply from the next semester (those who cancel their residency or leave the dormitory midway cannot re-apply in the same semester)
3. If an applicant takes leave of absence, is dismissed, takes credits below the standard stated in the eligibility, or does not return from leave of absence, the Dormitory Office may revoke your dormitory application and you cannot re-apply for dormitory. Also, you have a duty to notify the Dormitory Office of any changes in your status. Otherwise, you will be evicted and not allowed to re-apply

■ Facility Maintenance and Construction

1. If the dormitory is subjected to any maintenance work, there can be noises and entry of workers accompanied by staff members to the building
2. If an urgent temporary relocation to an alternative room or guest room is required due to repairs in the dormitory, the assigned room may differ from the current room type
